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Digging Deeper

1. Read Isaiah 53:4-6. What does it mean when Jesus took our sins upon himself? What does it not mean?
2. How does Matt. 27:45-46 relate to Isaiah 53:4-6? How is this suffering greater than the physical pain he endured?
3. Read Luke 22:41-44. What does the words of Jesus tell you about the choice that he was making? What does his choice tell you about his character?
4. How does John 20:24-28 relate to Revelation 5:6? Why does Jesus remain scarred forever?
5. How would your view of God be different if he had never suffered? How is your view of God different knowing the extent to which he suffered?

Living it Out

1. How does the physical, relational and spiritual suffering of Jesus compare to your personal suffering? How does Jesus' suffering effect your perspective and experience of your suffering?
2. How does the eternal scars of Jesus give you hope in your personal struggles?
3. Pick one person in your smaller groups and spend your entire prayer time praying for his or her needs.
